



Dallas Bailie Memorial Award - Criteria

The Dallas Bailie Memorial Award is to be presented annually to an individual that most exemplifies Dallas's spirit by volunteering in their community.

To qualify for the award the individual is not required to be a member of the Independent Insurance Agents Association of Contra Costa County but must be working in the independent insurance industry – such as an insurance company, insurance agency, or an associate business providing products or services to the insurance industry.

This person would be involved in their community by volunteering either through civic and/or non-profit organizations.

An award of not less than \$250 will be given to the recipient's charity of choice in their honor.

If there is no nominee in a given year the IIAACCC will make a donation of not less than \$250 to the Contra Costa Humane Society in Dallas Bailie's name.

All nominations are to be submitted to the IIAACCC Board of Directors no later than December 1st. The board will review and vote on those nominated at the December board meeting.

The award will be presented annually at the IIAACCC, NAIW, and CPCU Holiday Party.
